Please complete and return the Residence Hall Agreement and the Residence Life Information Form and a check or Money Order for a \$500.00 (U.S.) Room Reservation Fee/Damage Deposit to: Residence Life Office, 181 Main Street, Presque Isle, ME 04769-2888. Or you may fax these forms to (207) 768-9583. If you fax your forms, you must pay your deposit by credit card by calling the Business Office at (207) 768-9545.

Students are responsible for knowing all of the rules and regulations found in the Residence Hall Agreement, The Residence Hall Terms and Conditions, the Residence Hall Guide, the University of Maine System Conduct Code Policy, and the Student Handbook. Your room assignment will not be official until your deposit is on file. A deposit equal to one month's rent is required. \$100.00 of the Room Reservation Fee/Damage Deposit fee is non-refundable after June 1 for fall agreements and January 1 for new spring agreements. This agreement is binding through the end of the spring semester. Requests to cancel this agreement must be made through the Director of Residence Life. All refunds for room and board will be based on the Board of Trustees' Refund Policy as stated in the Student Handbook.

This is an application/agreement for space and does not guarantee assignment. UMPI will use your rooming preferences as much as possible, but reserves the right to assign students as space permits. If any provision of the agreement is determined to be invalid or unenforceable, it shall not affect the validity or enforcement of the remaining provisions hereof.
